CSIRT

▶ What is NAIST CSIRT?

It is a cross-functional emergency response team that works as a helpdesk when information security incidents occur. It was formed in October 2016.

▶ Who works as NAIST CSIRT?

Selected staff members of the Information Initiative Center (ITC) are the main members.
Some of the faculty in NAIST also work as team members.

What is an information security incident?

A malfunction of the network or the system, acts that trouble other users, and the risk of these are called "information security incidents." Examples include malware infection, web server hacking or tampering, and confidential information leakage.



▶ What NAIST CSIRT does?

Helpdesk in case of information security incidents	We consolidated the helpdesk for information security incidents. Even if incidents occur outside working hours, we will respond to them immediately in urgent cases.
Gather and analyze incident information, and immediate response	In information security incident cases, we take emergency responses such as isolation from the network, warnings and alerts, etc. After the incident is solved, we also consider additional measures to prevent recurrence.
Cooperate with information security organizations outside NAIST	We cooperate with other organizations such as CSIRTs in other universities, outside agencies, etc., and collect information so that we can respond to the evolving security incidents.
Prevent of information security incidents	We manage and inspect the information security monitors and implement the information security training and drills for faculty, staff and students in NAIST.
